Note: Half-day kindergarten does not participate in school lunch.

- Partner families receive lower tuition rates because their organizations offer substantial support to the school and to our non-Thai staff (who donate their salaries back to Grace).
- Payment of annual tuition in full by the due date will net a 1,000 baht discount per family.
- Payment of tuition quarterly will attract a 500 baht installment fee per quarter per family.

Silver

Qualification:

- Founders who provide any staff
- Board Qualified Associates who provide staff at 1:10 ratio or better
- Associates who provide staff at 1:3 ratio or better

Discount:

25% off Grades 7-8 Partner Tuition rounded to nearest 500 baht

Gold

Qualification:

- Founders who provide staff at 1:10 ratio or better
- Board Qualified Associates who provide staff at 1:3 ratio or better

Discount:

30% off Grades 7-8 Partner Tuition rounded to nearest 500 baht

Platinum

Qualification:

- Founders who provide staff at 1:3 ratio or better

Discount:

35% off Grades 7-8 Partner Tuition rounded to nearest 500 baht



Additional Fees

First Year Students

Application Fee	5,000 baht	<i>This is a non-refundable fee due with each application. An application form must be completed for each child.</i>
Entrance Fee	67,000 baht (Partners 50% discount)	<i>This non-refundable fee secures a classroom place for your child. The entrance fee is due within four weeks of the date on the letter of acceptance or the first day the student attends school if the application is approved in July or later.</i>

Returning Students

Re-enrollment Fee	10,000 baht	<i>This non-refundable fee is due every year by January 31 to secure your child's seat and to enable the school to purchase books and supplies for the next school year.</i>

Chromebook Fee	1,000 baht	<i>This non-refundable fee is due by August 15 for Chromebook insurance.</i>

All Students

Capitalization Fee	28,000 baht (Partners 50% discount)	<i>This non-refundable fee helps pay for new construction at the school or for replacing capital items that have served their useful life. The capitalization fee is due with tuition at the beginning of each school year regardless of whether the student attends first, second, or both semesters.</i>

Multiple Child Discount

Tuition is assessed at the full applicable rate for the first three children enrolled. Each additional sibling will receive the Bronze discount on tuition only.

School Lunch Program

GIS is happy to offer a quality hot lunch program. A variety of Thai and western-style foods are offered, as well as a daily salad bar.

Prices per semester are as follows:

Grade K-2	3,500 baht/semester
Grade 3-6	3,900 baht/semester
Grade 7-12	5,700 baht/semester

The school lunch plan can be purchased by semester but not by day and is due with tuition at the beginning of each semester. Students miss several meals per semester due to school-sponsored trips, sending organization activities, medical needs, or other reasons and this has been factored into the price. If a child misses more than 25 school days of the semester, the finance office may be able to discount the price.

Menus for each quarter can be found on the school website. New students are invited to try the lunch program the first week without obligation. Parents may join their children for lunch by notifying the office two (2) days in advance and paying an adult guest fee.

A student who withdraws and who does not attend GIS for two school years or more must begin the application process again. For tuition and fee purposes, they will be assessed payments as a new student.

Tuition and Fee Payment Options

Method of payment

Tuition and fees can be paid in the following ways:

- direct deposit into a GIS bank accounts
- check/cheque (baht)
- cash (baht)
- credit card (add 3% convenience fee)

For security reasons, the school prefers to receive payment by direct deposit, check/cheque, or credit card. Cash payments should be made by an adult. Do not send payments with children. If your organization is making payments on your behalf, the finance office will work out a plan for them upon request.

The tuition for each family will be paid according to one of the following schedules:

1. Annual Plan

- Annual tuition is due on August 15, 2020
- A **1,000 baht discount** will be applied for payment of annual tuition in full by the due date.

2. Semester Plan

The annual tuition shall be divided into two (2) equal payments, due on the beginning of each semester:

- First semester: August 15, 2020
- Second semester: January 15, 2021

3. Quarterly Plan

The annual tuition shall be divided into four (4) equal payments, due on the first day of each quarter:

- First quarter: August 15, 2020
- Second quarter: October 15, 2020
- Third quarter: January 15, 2021
- Fourth quarter: March 15, 2021
- A **500 baht installment fee per quarter** will be assessed if the quarterly tuition plan is selected.

For all tuition payment plans, the **capitalization fee is due by August 15, 2020. The **re-enrollment fee** is due by January 31, 2021 with a Student Re-Admission Form to secure your child's place for the following school year.*

Student Visa

In order to obtain a student visa, **tuition must be paid in full for the entire year.**

Late Fees

Accounts will be **automatically assessed 1.5% interest per month** (prorated by day) on all past-due tuition and fees according to the payment schedule shown on the invoice. If there is a problem meeting payment deadlines, please contact the chief financial officer (CFO) at finance.director@gisthailand.org before the due date to discuss the situation and sign a formal Late Payment Agreement.

Delinquent Accounts

The CFO will ask parents with past-due accounts to negotiate suitable payment arrangements so their children can continue attending class. If arrangements are not made, the school may take action up to and including disenrollment.

Refunds

Only tuition fees are refundable. Other school fees are non-refundable. Attendance during any part of a quarter requires payment for the entire quarter. It is the responsibility of the parents to apply for a tuition refund at the registrar's office. Tuition refunds not claimed within three months of withdrawal from Grace International School are no longer refundable and become the property of the school.
