2022-2023 Annual Tuition Rates and Fees (Baht)

Note: There is an option for full-day kindergarten with the same tuition rate as Grade 1.

- Member families receive lower tuition rates because their organizations offer substantial support to both GIS and to our non-Thai staff (who donate their salaries back to Grace).
- Payment of annual tuition in full by the due date will net a 1,000-baht discount per family.
- Payment of tuition quarterly will attract a 500-baht installment fee per quarter per family.

Bronze

Qualification:

- Founders who provide no staff
- Board Qualified Associates who provide any staff
- Associates who provide staff at 1:10 ratio or better

Discount:

20% off Grades 7-8 Member Tuition rounded to nearest 500 baht

Silver

Qualification:

- Founders who provide any staff
- Board Qualified Associates who provide staff at 1:10 ratio or better
- Associates who provide staff at 1:3 ratio or better

Discount:

25% off Grades 7-8 Member Tuition rounded to nearest 500 baht

Gold

Qualification:

- Founders who provide staff at 1:10 ratio or better
- Board Qualified Associates who provide staff at 1:3 ratio or better

Discount:

30% off Grades 7-8 Member Tuition rounded to nearest 500 baht

Platinum

Qualification:

- Founders who provide staff at 1:3 ratio or better

Discount:

35% off Grades 7-8 Member Tuition rounded to nearest 500 baht



Additional Fees

First Year Students

Testing Fee ————— **3,000 baht**

Application Fee ——— **2,000 baht**

These non-refundable fees are payable for each child applying to GIS.

Entrance Fee ————— **67,000 baht (Members 50% discount)**

This non-refundable fee secures a place for your child. It is due within four weeks of the date on the letter of acceptance or the first day of school if the application is approved in July or later.

Returning Students

Re-enrollment Fee — **10,000 baht**

This non-refundable fee is due every year by January 31 to secure your child's seat.

All Students

Capitalization Fee — **28,000 baht (Members 50% discount)**

This non-refundable fee helps fund new construction at the school and replace fixed assets that have reached the end of their useful lives. The capitalization fee is due with tuition at the beginning of each school year regardless of whether the student attends first, second, or both semesters.

Multiple Child Discount

Tuition is assessed at the full applicable rate for the first three children enrolled. Each additional sibling will receive a 20% discount off the applicable rate on tuition only.

School Lunch Program

GIS is happy to offer a quality hot lunch program. A variety of Thai and western-style foods are offered, as well as a daily salad bar. Prices per semester are as follows:

Grade K-2 — 3,800 baht/semester

Grade 3-6 — 4,250 baht/semester

Grade 7-12 — 6,150 baht/semester

School lunch can be purchased by semester (not by day/week), and payment is due at the start of each semester. Students typically miss several meals per semester due to school-sponsored trips, activities, etc., and this has been factored into the price. If a student misses more than 25 school days during a semester, the finance office may be able to discount the price. Menus for each month can be found on the school website. New students may try school lunch the first week for free. Parents may pay an adult guest fee at reception to join their children for lunch.

[A student who does not attend GIS for two or more school years must submit a new application. For tuition and fees, he or she will be assessed as a new student.](#)

Tuition and Fee Payment Options

Method of payment

Tuition and fees can be paid in the following ways:

- direct deposit into a GIS bank account
- check/cheque (baht)
- cash (baht)
- credit card (add 3% convenience fee)

For security reason, the school prefers to receive payment by direct deposit, cheque/check, or credit card. Cash payments should be made by an adult. Do not send payments with children. If your organization is making payments on your behalf, the finance office will work out a plan for them upon request.

The tuition for each family will be paid according to one of the following schedules:

1. Annual Plan

- Annual tuition is due on August 15, 2022
- A **1,000-baht discount** will be applied for payment of annual tuition in full by the due date.

2. Semester Plan

The annual tuition shall be divided into two (2) equal payments due at the beginning of each semester:

- First semester: August 15, 2022
- Second semester: January 15, 2023

3. Quarterly Plan

The annual tuition shall be divided into four (4) equal payments due on the first day of each quarter:

- First quarter: August 15, 2022
- Second quarter: October 15, 2022
- Third quarter: January 15, 2023
- Fourth quarter: March 15, 2023
- A **500-baht installment fee per quarter** will be assessed if the quarterly tuition plan is selected.

For all tuition payment plans, the **capitalization fee is due by August 15, 2022. The **re-enrollment fee** is due by January 31, 2023, with a Student Re-Admission Form to secure your child's place for the following school year.*

Student Visa

To obtain a student visa, **the capitalization fee and tuition must be paid in full for the year.**

Late Fees

Accounts will be **automatically assessed 15% interest per month** (prorated by day) on all past-due tuition and fees according to the payment schedule on the invoice. If there is a problem meeting payment deadlines, please contact the chief financial officer (CFO) at finance@gisthailand.org before the due date to discuss the situation and sign a formal Late Payment Agreement.

Delinquent Accounts

The CFO will ask parents with past-due accounts to negotiate suitable payment arrangements so their children can continue attending class. If arrangements are not made, the school may take action up to and including disenrollment.

Refunds

Only tuition fees are refundable. Other school fees are non-refundable.

Attendance during any part of a quarter requires payment for the entire quarter. It is the responsibility of the parents to apply for a tuition refund at the registrar's office. Tuition refunds not claimed within three months of withdrawal from Grace International School are no longer refundable and become the property of the school.
